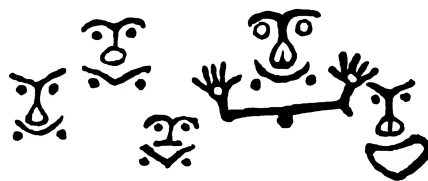


Interning at the Alutiiq Museum



Quyanaa – Thank you for your interest in working as an intern at the Alutiiq Museum. Each year we receive many requests from students and museum professionals interested in broadening their experiences with an internship in Kodiak. While the Alutiiq Museum does not maintain a paid internship program, we are pleased to work with interns in the following ways.

1. **Unpaid Internships:** People wishing to intern at the Alutiiq Museum in an unpaid capacity are welcome to volunteer their time. We can work with you to design an internship that meets your professional, scholarly, or personal goals.
2. **Grant Funded or Corporate Sponsored Internships:** Potential interns are welcome to speak to us about developing their own funding proposals to intern at the Alutiiq Museum. In the past, we have had interns who raised support from Native corporations, employers, schools and grants to support the costs associated with an Alutiiq Museum internship.

Although we do not have funding to support interns, we can often help you design an internship, and provide mentoring and supervision in Kodiak.
